



Garonga Safari Camp and Little Garonga are unassuming sanctuaries promising an intimate wildlife encounter in an unhurried environment where you can unwind, sleep deeply and be yourself. Garonga is owner managed and a proud member of Classic Safari Camps of Africa.

Location

The greater Makalali Conservancy situated west of the Kruger National Park

Accommodation

Garonga Safari Camp's **6 fully en-suite luxury tents** are situated overlooking a dry riverbed - each with a wooden deck complete with hammock that commands spectacular views. The rooms are light, airy and spacious with large, draped beds. In addition to the indoor shower, there is an outdoor shower, providing the perfect link with Mother Nature. Each room is very well appointed and even includes yoga mats.

Little Garonga has **3 fully en-suite, thatched and air-conditioned suites**, all situated around centralized indoor/outdoor lounge areas, a swimming pool and built-in braai/BBQ area. Each suite has a covered deck area, hammock and lounge. The bathrooms consist of a bath, basins and shower. A large outdoor shower is also available.

The Chiltern and Buckingham suites are suitable for two people sharing.

Little Garonga's Hambleden suite consists of a main bedroom (catering for 2 adults) and a second bedroom that can accommodate 2 children, both with en suite bathrooms, making it ideally suited for a couple or a small family. The suite has its own swimming pool.

Garonga Safari Camp – Minimum age 12 years. No extra beds in tents.

Little Garonga - Children aged 6 – 15 years are welcome at Little Garonga, and the Hambleden Suite has an adjoining room with twin beds and 2 bathrooms to accommodate a maximum of 2 children sharing with 2 adults. Children's rates available on request. Regrettably children under the age of 6 cannot be accommodated.

Camp Closure Dates

The camp closes for the first three weeks of every March for maintenance.

Access

- Airlink flight from Johannesburg to Hoedspruit or Phalaborwa. Then 75 minute road transfer
- Cemair or SA Express flight from Johannesburg (1h 10min) or Cape Town (2h 15min) to Hoedspruit.
- Airlink flight from Cape Town or Johannesburg to KMIA then a further charter to Garonga (45 mins) Road transfer not recommended
- Road transfers from Hoedspruit or Phalaborwa (75 mins) can be booked with Garonga Reservations.
- Air Charters from Hoedspruit/Phalaborwa to Garonga's airstrip with Kingdom Air (20 mins)
- Chartered flights are available from Johannesburg to Garonga's airstrip with Federal Air. (90 mins)
- Approx six/seven hour drive from Johannesburg to Garonga including 50 minutes on a dirt road.

Highlight– Garonga’s Sleep Out Experience

Sleep out in the wild on the beautiful deck in the middle of the bush with stunning views over the veld. A romantic four poster bed with mosquito netting ensures a good night’s sleep, with a convenient wash basin and toilet on a separate deck. Guests are left overnight in ultimate seclusion with a sumptuous 3-course dinner, a cooler box (with the all-important drinks of their choice), teas and coffees and a radio to contact the main camp, which is a 20 minute drive away.

Rates

- Rates include all meals, accommodation, all game drives, bush walks and bush baths. Rates also include all soft drinks, house wines, local beers and local spirits.
- Excludes Conservation Levy:
 Park entrance fee per person on 1st day
 Anti-poaching levy per person per day 2nd day onwards.

Climate

September – April (High Season). Rains: Average 450mm pa. Can reach up to 40 degrees C in peak summer and fall to 25 degrees C at night. It starts cooling down from March.

May – August (Low Season). Generally no rain at this time. Cold mornings and evenings/night. Temperatures reach about 25 Degrees C max during the day and fall to between 5 - 10 Degrees C at night. Electric Blankets are put in the beds during the winter. It can be very cold on game drives first thing in the mornings due to wind chill factor on the vehicles. Blankets provided.

What to bring

High Season: Waterproof jacket, swimming costume, light cotton type clothing, sandals, good walking boots, and a cap/hat.
 Low Season: Fleece, jacket, jersey, scarf, gloves, cap/hat.
 Other useful items: Camera, Binoculars, Adaptor Plug, Sun Cream, Sunglasses.
