



The Gomoti tree is locally known as the water fig and grows alongside waterways in the Okavango delta. It's a smallish tree which sometimes grows no bigger than a bush. The Gomoti trees line the waterways and provide excellent cover for nesting water birds such as herons and storks. Gomoti Plains Camp is waiting to spoil guests with its classical comfort and amazing wildlife. Travel the waterways by motor boat and mokoro and traverse the Gomoti plains enthralling in the dense wildlife concentrations of the Gomoti area.

Location

Gomoti Plains Camp is located in south-east area of the Okavango Delta in the Gomoti Private Concession. The Camp is situated on one of the smaller flood plains along the Gomoti River system.

The area is known for its large concentrations of wildlife which thrive on the Gomoti plains and waterways. This exclusive area has been a well-kept secret for many years. The Gomoti region has been the local haunt of many of the older guides and Okavango dwellers who refer to it in nostalgic terms when they used to camp along this river system. This wild and pristine area has over the years produced some phenomenal wildlife encounters including the filming and studying of the African wild dog packs which inhabit this area.

Activities

Dining

The food served at camp is a wonderful mixture of local cuisine flavoured and cooked in good old fashion home style cooking. We call this bushfare. The chefs come from Botswana and have many years working in the tourism industry preparing fine meals. We try and eat under the stars at night and vary our dining experiences with every meal.

Accommodation

Ten luxury safari tents, two of which are family units. These large tents are raised on wooden decks as are the main areas of the lodge. The tents are decorated in a classic safari style incorporating the land and water of the Okavango delta. Luxurious, comfortable, classic. All eight double tents take two guests and the two family rooms can hold four guests. All rooms have hot and cold running water, inside and outside showers, flush toilets and twin basins. Electricity in the tents is reserved for lighting and charging of batteries and computers. There are no hairdryers but the tents do have international plugs.

Wi-Fi

There is no Wi-Fi in the tents or main areas, limited Wi-Fi can be accessed near the office.



Access

- Access to Gomoti Plains is by air only
- Gomoti Plains is a 15 – 20 minute charter flight from Maun
- Gomoti Plains is a 50 – 60 minute charter flight from Kasane
- There is a 30 Minute drive from the airstrip to camp but can vary if water levels are high
- Inter-camp flight transfers can also be booked

A maximum of 20kg of luggage per person is allowed for light aircraft flights, including hand luggage and camera equipment. Please ensure that all luggage is soft-sided. Only bags without wheels are permitted. Luggage dimensions should not exceed 25cm (10 inches) wide, 30cm (12 inches) high and 62 cm (24 inches) long. Passengers weighing between 110 – 120 kg (242 – 264 lbs.) please need to advise reservations when making a booking, so they can in turn advise Mack Air for scheduling purposes.

Health Precautions

Because Botswana is a malaria area, precautions are recommended. All travellers coming from or going through countries which have been declared yellow fever infected areas must provide an international health certificate of vaccination for yellow fever upon arrival into Botswana.

The water in camp is safe to drink.

Child & Sharing Policy

- Children of all ages welcome.
- A private vehicle is required for children under 6 participating in game activities.
- Children aged 5 years and younger stay free, children 6-11 pay standard child rate (50% of adult sharing rate). Children 12+ pay full adult rate.
- No more than two children under 12 years of age in family luxury tent with two adults (additional children on request, please speak to reservations).
- One child and one adult in standard luxury tent pay adult + child rate.
- Two adults permitted to stay in family luxury tent with two other adults at full adult rate.
- It is mandatory for a private vehicle to be booked for guests travelling with children under the age of 6.
- No children under 12 allowed to participate in Mokoro and Game Walk activities.
- No babysitting facilities available.

Rates

Rates are fully inclusive of accommodation, all meals, laundry, lodge activities, return vehicle airstrip transfers, alcoholic & non-alcoholic beverages (excluding imported and premium drinks), levies & taxes.

Rates exclude international flights, internal flight transfers, premium imports, travel insurance, visas and discretionary tips.
