



Verney's Camp joined the Machaba Safaris group in 2017 with a totally clean piece of unspoilt wilderness in Zimbabwe. Verney's Camp has been built in keeping with Machaba Safaris' winning recipe that matches the timeless wonder of a classic safari to Africa, aimed at the affordable luxury travel markets worldwide for both the novice and the well-seasoned safari traveller.

Location

Situated on the central side of the south eastern part of Hwange National Park, Verney's Camp is a private concession of 10 000 hectares (24,7 acres). It is in a remote part of the National Park that is not accessed by regular Park visitors, however the camp does have access to the public parts of the National Park.

The Camp is located at Verney's Pan, which is situated on a large open floodplain surrounded by teak forest typical of Hwange National Park. The waterhole at Verney's plays host to numerous animals and is a playground for the famous elephant herds of Hwange.

Accommodation

Ten tents are tucked perfectly under the shady arms of the teak trees bordering the open waterhole in front of camp. Each tent has been carefully positioned to ensure the best serenity and privacy so that guests can enjoy the natural beauty of the area. Each room is comfortably appointed and has en suite shower, flush toilet, double vanity, all beautifully designed to retain the authenticity and magical feeling of being on safari. Verney's Camp has eight double/twin tents and two family tents, all of which sit at ground level and are connected by natural pathways.

- 8 x Luxury Tents
- 2 x Family Luxury Tents (2 bedrooms & 2 bathrooms)

Activities

Verney's is situated in a natural amphitheatre in one of the best wildlife areas in Hwange so there is some fantastic game viewing either while out on activities or at the waterhole located in front of the camp.

- Morning, evening & night game drives at times to suit guests.
- All day drives with Picnic lunch.
- Walking: usually done by initially driving to one of the best walking areas.
- Game viewing from the comfort of your own tent. During the dry season, animals come down to drink at the waterhole right in front of the camp main area.
- Relax and appreciate being in the African bush.
- Play bridge at the antique bridge table
- Cool off in the swimming pool
- Cultural visits to the local community

Cultural Experience

An interesting and informative half day trip.

Breakfast at 7am & depart on a leisurely game drive north east towards Hwange Main Camp (approx. 2 hours). Visit The National Parks Primary School that Verney's Camp have adopted and sponsor (along with other operators in Hwange National Park). Travel to Mabale Village, an authentic rural village typical to the area and meet the local residents. Visit The Painted Dog Research Centre to learn more about the endangered African Wild Dog. Meet the researchers and get involved in future sponsorship of this critical study. Picnic lunch at one of the numerous waterholes on the way back to Verney's for a relaxing afternoon.



Child & Sharing Policy

- Children of all ages welcome.
- A private vehicle is required for children under 6 participating in game activities.
- Children aged 5 years and younger stay free, children 6-11 pay standard child rate (50% of adult sharing rate).
- Children 12+ pay full adult rate.
- Generally no more than two children under 12 years of age in a family tent with two adults (additional children on request via reservations).
- One child and one adult in standard luxury tent pay adult + child rate.
- Two adults permitted to stay in family luxury tent with two other adults at full adult rate.
- No children under 12 allowed to participate in Game Walk activities.
- No babysitting facilities available.

Health Precautions

Because Zimbabwe is a malaria area, precautions are recommended.

The water in camp is safe to drink.
