Machaba is a family owned collection of 4 classical safari camps – 3 of which are in Botswana’s iconic Okavango Delta and a brand new fourth camp which opened this month (1 May 2018) in Hwange, Zimbabwe. The lodges offer excellent value for money and a true wilderness experience including mekoro (canoe) safaris, game drives and walks – from the novice safari guest to seasoned safari travellers.

#### **Machaba Camp**

Located on an island in the Khwai Concession on the river, bordering the Moremi Game Reserve. It was named after the Sycamore Fig Tree and has a classic 1950’s style. There are 10 luxury safari tents - all with ensuite bathrooms and outdoor showers. This includes 8 twins and 2 family tents, all of which are situated at ground level, linked by pathways meandering between the trees. The camp welcomes children of all ages, and is wheelchair-friendly. Access is via Maun Airport (25-30 minute flight) or Kasane (45- 60 minute flight) and then a 30 minute drive to Camp.

#### **Little Machaba**

This intimate camp is situated on the same island as Machaba Camp but is run separately. There are only 4 spacious safari tents, which are all situated on decks, linked by pathways meandering under large riverine trees with views over the plains frequented by elephants. Little Machaba offers 2 twins and 2 luxury family safari tents and is ideal for romantic travellers, honeymoon couples, or those who prefer a more private safari experience.

#### **Gomoti Plains**

Located in an exclusive concession in the south eastern section of the Okavango Delta, Gomoti Plains offers the perfect pairing with the Machaba Camps. It comprises 8 twin tents and 2 family tents, with décor inspired from the theme of water and land. The camp welcomes children of all ages and is wheelchair-friendly.

#### **Verney’s Camp**

This brand new camp opened on 1 May 2018 in a private concession in the heart of Hwange National Park in Zimbabwe, with its remote 10,000 hectares rarely accessed by other visitors. The camp boasts 10 safari tents (8 twins and 2 family tents) on wooden decks surrounded by a teak forest and overlooks a busy waterhole frequented by Hwange’s famous elephants. Access is via a 1 hour flight from Vic Falls Airport to Manga Airstrip and then a 45 transfer.
