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Explore Kigali By Bus



Rwanda welcomes approximately 1.3 million foreign tourists per year - and one of the best, most cost effective ways to explore its Capital, Kigali is the [Kigali City Tour bus](#) which was launched earlier this year. The double decker, open-top bus runs 3 tours a day from Mondays to Saturdays, departing from the Kigali Business Centre Mall. The bus visits over 60 historical and contemporary sites over the day and is equipped with a toilet, air conditioner, WI-FI, charging portals and digital screens. Tickets for international tourists are \$40pp, \$20 East Africans and \$15 for locals and allow you to hop on and hop off all day on your “urban safari”. On request, guests can be picked up or dropped off at the Kigali Serena Hotel.

- **Old Kigali Tour** - The 3-hour long morning tour departs at 9am and includes stops at the Prime Minister’s Office, Payage, Sainte-Famille Church, Umuhima Hill, Rubangura place and the Kigali Genocide Memorial which commemorates the 1994 genocide against the Tutsi.
- **New Kigali Tour** - The 3-hour long afternoon tour departs at 2pm includes KLab (Knowledge Lab), Inema Arts Center, Gacuriro & Vision City Estates, Kimironko Market and the Heroes Memorial Site.
- **Kigali night life Tour** – The evening tour departs at 7pm and concludes around 11pm. Highlights include Kicukiro, Nyanza Genocide Memorial Site, Kigali Cultural Village, Kimihurura and Gisiment. The tour includes great panoramic views over the city by night and a pub crawl to some of the city’s “hot spots” such as the Fuschia Lounge Bar offering great food, drinks and dancing.

Serena also offers private tours to The Genocide Memorial, The Inema Art Centre, The Nyamirambo Women’s Centre and “Kandt House” Natural History Museum.
