Garonga is also involved in all the various conservation projects in the Makalali, which include the introduction of a disease free buffalo herd, the K9 Conservation Anti-poaching unit, the reintroduction of various endangered species and the rhino conservation project.

Garonga are an active partner in a rhino conservation project led by the World Wildlife Fund (WWF) in the Greater Makalali Private Game Reserve called the Black Rhino Range Expansion Project. This involves funding rhino relocations as well as teams of field rangers and working dogs that dedicate their lives to fighting rhino poaching in the Makalali.
