Kambaku is the only lodge with access to both the Timbavati and Klaserie Reserves. Safaris are enjoyed on game drives and on foot and the reserve is renowned for its rare white lions and African wild dogs.

Located a stone's throw from the seaside town of Knysna, this boutique B&B is located up in the hills of Sedgefield. It boasts just 5 luxury suites set in 40 hectares of unspoilt fynbos overlooking the Swartvlei estuary - encircled by mountains and forests. Here, your closest neighbours include bushbuck, honey badgers, otters and tortoises. There is a jungle gym and toy box for children and an extra bed/cot can be added to all suites.
