FOODIE HEAVEN AT MAJEKA'S MAKARON



Majeka House in the Stellenbosch winelands is a stylish, fabulously quirky, boutique hotel with just 23 rooms tucked away in the leafy suburbs of Stellenbosch – that was recognised internationally for its world class interior design when it was named the Best Design Hotel in Africa & the Middle East at the Condé Nast Johansens Awards for Excellence 2017.

It is also one of the best hot spots for foodies wanting to explore the Cape Winelands. Last year, Makaron was nominated in two categories for Condé Nast Gourmet Restaurant Awards as well as again being listed amongst the Top 30 restaurants nominated for the annual Eat Out Awards.

Head Chef Lucas Carstens loves to tantalise the taste buds with his innovative 'small plates' menu, which offers a variety of 18 small plates, broken up into 'Suggested Start', 'Followed Up By', 'The Serious Choice' and 'To Finish'. Diners can choose four/five/six courses from the ['small plates' menu](#) for R460/R575/R690 respectively. An optional wine pairing is also available, at a cost of R790/R960/R1125 for both food and wine. Makaron Restaurant is open daily for dinner only from 18:30 – 21:00.

During the day the cool, sophisticated MLounge serves a concise selection of cocktails, gourmet bar snacks and bistro dishes - think steak frites with bearnaise, or a country terrine with toasted brioche which can be enjoyed in the lounge or in the garden under the trees.
