

KIRI CAMP- OPENING June 2022



There is no more exciting and traditional way to explore the Okavango Delta than by Mokoro. These 'dugout' canoes have been enabling locals to navigate the ever changing Delta waterways for centuries and, more recently, offer visitors the chance to explore otherwise inaccessible remote areas of the Delta with a highly trained poler who guides the mokoro with his ngashi, the pole. Gently meandering the waterways with your vantage point at water level will give guests a whole different perspective of the Delta. Here you will notice the stunning colours of the water lilies nestled amongst the papyrus and reeds that make up a large part of the vegetation of the Delta and also give shelter to the Delta crocodiles.

The Okavango Delta, the largest inland delta on Earth, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa. One of the most exquisitely scenic and prolific game-viewing and birding experiences in the world, it is also home to ethnic groups who are deeply in tune with the natural world surrounding them. The delta is habitat to more than 400 species of birds, nearly 200 species of mammals and over 150 species of reptiles.

A safari retreat based at Kiri Camp will immerse you in this incredible wilderness. Located on an island, flanked by the Kiri channel, this private concession enables guests to enjoy off roading, night drives and guided walks with armed rangers in addition to the serene mokoro experience or an exhilarating motorboat ride.

Kiri Camp is raised on wooden decks to give a view of the mighty Kiri floodplains which stretch out in front of the camp. The luxury tents are designed to incorporate the surrounding ebony forest under which the camp is situated enabling it to blend into the background. This ensures that the animals remain the main event and what an event! Here you will not only encounter the Big Five, but you have an excellent chance of viewing rare wild dog, wild dog dens and elephants in herds up to 1000!

Kiri Camp continues the Machaba Safaris tradition of eco-luxury. Tents are spacious with decadent ensuite bathrooms under the stars. These are linked to the central guest lounge and dining areas, as well as the swimming pool, by natural pathways through the bush – with Machaba's firm focus, as always, on making a minimal impact on the environment.
