FOODIE ALERT

Not only is Majeka House well located for exploring the Winelands, but you don’t even have to venture outside of the hotel to enjoy some incredible locally sourced delights at the hotel itself. Dishes on offer during the day range from mouth-watering burgers to apple donuts, all overseen by the talented Vuyo Ngcayi. Particular favourites that can be enjoyed throughout the day and into the evening in the MLounge are the platters of local cheeses or meats that are ideal for sharing. Pair that with a fynbos mojito and you are set for the night!

SPA

The hotel offers both single and couples treatment rooms at its spa and guests love the heated hydrotherapy indoor swimming pool, jacuzzi, steam room and sauna.
